How to Enter

The only way to enter the The Smoke Show Driving Camp Raffle is by visiting www.TonyStewartFoundation.org to purchase your ticket online through a secure site owned and maintained by Charity Splits.

Phone, Fax, U.S. Mail or Email entries will NOT be accepted under any circumstance.

Raffle tickets are \$10 (1 ticket); \$20 (3 tickets); or \$30 (6 tickets). You may buy as many individual tickets or ticket combinations as you like. Only one name will appear on each ticket. Please, no international orders or international credit cards. You must be 18 years of age or older to purchase a raffle ticket and enter the drawing. Tickets will be sold online through 6:00 pm EDT on Thursday, July 14, 2011.

Also please note, the IRS does not allow money spent on raffle tickets to be tax deductible contributions.

Charity Splits accepts Visa, MasterCard, and Discover for payment.

Rules

Charity Splits "The Smoke Show Driving Camp" Raffle Official Rules and Regulations

By purchasing a Raffle ticket the purchaser agrees to be bound by these rules and regulations. Charity Splits' interpretation and application of these rules and regulations shall be final.

The Single Prize Drawing for the Raffle will be held on July 14, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. EDT. Tickets will not be sold after July 14, 2011, 5:00 p.m. EDT. Tickets may sell out before that time. An independent raffle auditor will supervise the drawing. The winner need not be present to win.

Only **8,014** tickets will be sold. The chances of winning are based on that number. If fewer tickets are sold, your chances of winning the Grand Prize and other prizes improve. The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has taken the position that amounts paid for chances in raffles, lotteries or similar drawings for valuable prizes are not gifts, and consequently do not qualify as deductible charitable contributions.

If the Single Prize Smoke Show Driving Camp Package is accepted as the prize, the Prize winner shall assume all fees, local, state and federal taxes.

Tickets:

Raffle tickets are \$10 (1 ticket); \$20 (3 tickets); or \$30 (6 tickets). Only one eligible person may be entered in the Raffle per ticket sold. If the name of more than one person is submitted with a ticket purchase, and that ticket is selected as a winning ticket, then the person named first will be deemed the holder of record of that ticket and declared the winner. Division of prize by a group purchasing a ticket in common shall be to the sole responsibility of the person named as the holder of record of that ticket, should that ticket be selected as a winner. Winners are responsible for checking their email for winning notification. If a ticket purchaser changes their e-mail during a raffle, it is the purchaser's sole responsibility to have their e-mail forwarded to their current e-mail address. Purchasers must fill out all personal information on the ticket purchase page for verification purposes. The name and address on the personal information section must match the name and address on the credit card used to make the raffle ticket purchase.

How to Purchase:

An individual can purchase as many Raffle tickets as he or she may wish, subject to availability.

To purchase Raffle tickets: Tickets may only be purchased online via a link found at www.TonyStewartFoundation.org to a secure online purchase site owned and managed by Charity Splits. No refunds will be made except under the following circumstances: any ticket order with payment received after 8,014 tickets have been sold or after July 14, 2011, 5:00 p.m. EDT, will be returned. No other refunds are available except in the exclusive discretion of Charity Splits. Charity Splits on behalf of The Tony Stewart Foundation assumes no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected or non-delivered mail or fax messages, or any other failure to receive orders or deliver receipts prior to the drawing deadlines. A Raffle ticket will be void and a prize not paid/redeemed if there is proof that the ticket was stolen, non-issued, ineligible, altered counterfeit in whole or in part, defective, printed in duplicate or printed/produced in error. It shall be the sole responsibility of the ticket purchaser to verify the accuracy and condition of the data printed on the Official On-Line Raffle ticket at the time of purchase. If On-Line Raffle Ticket submitted for validation is suspect or fails any of the preceding validation conditions the ticket shall be considered void, subject to the following determinations:

1. In all cases of doubt, the determination of The Tony Stewart Foundation and shall be final and binding. However, TSF may in their discretion, refund the ticket purchaser the cost of the ticket purchased.
2. In the event a defective ticket is purchased or in the event Charity Splits determines an error occurred or to adjust an error, the sole and exclusive remedy shall be the refund of the purchase price of the ticket.
3. In the event a ticket is not paid by TSF and a dispute occurs as to whether the ticket is a winning ticket, the TSF may, at its option, refund the purchase price of the ticket. This shall be the sole and exclusive remedy, of the holder of the ticket;
 - a. Unauthorized persons copying, selling, or altering tickets are subject to prosecution
4. Winner will be notified by email. Charity Splits will use the e-mail address given at the time of purchase by the purchaser. *Important- please be aware that some email services may file your ticket information in a spam or junk mail folders, if you do not immediately receive a ticket confirmation email in your inbox, please check your spam or junk mail. It is the ticket purchaser's sole responsibility to confirm ticket information and purchase. TSF/Charity Splits is not responsible for incorrect e-mail addresses. On-Line Game Raffle drawings shall be conducted at a time and location as determined by TSF/Charity Splits.
5. In order to be deemed a valid Official On-Line Raffle winning ticket, all of the following conditions must be met:
 - a. The validation data must be present in its entirety and must correspond, using the computer validation file, to the number selections printed on the ticket for the drawing date(s) and, if applicable, drawing time, printed on the ticket.
 - b. The ticket must be sufficiently intact to permit validation;
 - c. The ticket must not be intentionally mutilated, altered, reconstituted, or tampered with in any manner;

Selection of Winners:

The Smoke Show Driving Camp Raffle drawing will be held on July 14, 2011, from all eligible Raffle tickets. Winners need not be present to win. CHARITY SPLITS Software will conduct the Grand Prize drawing which will be held under the supervision of an independent raffle auditor. All drawings are open to the public. Winners will be notified according to the contact information provided to CHARITY SPLITS at the time of ticket purchase. ***If the Grand Prize winner has not contacted Charity Splits by 5:00 p.m. EDT on or before the 7th day following the***

drawing, the Grand Prize winner forfeits his/her right to the Grand Prize. It is solely the responsibility of the ticket purchaser to provide current and correct contact information to Charity Splits. Charity Splits nor the Tony Stewart Foundation shall be held responsible for contact information that is no longer current or valid for the individual purchasing a ticket(s).
